Dear Bill:

I have reviewed your open records request and have come to the following conclusions:

Attached you will find the Madison Police Department Parking Ticket totals for 2007 through October. The document includes names of parking enforcement officers and their monthly ticket totals as requested.

Your request did not seek any explanation for the differences in ticket numbers between PEO Officers. I feel it is important to add this additional information to provide you clarity in your decision to use these names and numbers.

The primary role of a Parking Enforcement Officer is to enforce Madison General Ordinances in regards to parking violations. Though all officers have this task, specific job responsibilities vary greatly amongst the staff. The following are variables that factor in to the number of citations issued by PEO Officers.

1. Shift and hours worked.
2. Assignments (meters, restricted parking, alternate side, ect.)
3. District assigned (West, South, Central, North, East)
4. Weather
5. Leave Time
6. Special Events
