
This is totally unacceptable if we believe Jesus—then, everyone joyfully gives what they have been given; and everyone receives what they need. Consequently, when we ride on my last journey and I am asked "Why" (as I often am) I will say: I joyfully ride and live deliberately because I too will die, and we ride wherever God is as long as we let Jesus lead. **IF YOU WISH TO HELP, PLEASE UNITE WITH JESUS' LEAD:** In your heart you know, He informs us all of God's will: give and Give—Do for others—It is that simple!

I can think I can wait, I can fast, although; I have found on previous journeys that I seldom have to fast. Most people like horses and children. Many a child has had their first ride on a noble steed: thus my daily bowl is filled because I am with them—But this journey is not about me—There are children in the world that are so hungry that God cannot appear to them except in the form of food—this is our mission—It is God's plan—we ride as ambassadors of God possessed by the Holy Spirit, protected by the people of God, in Jesus' footsteps from one city to the next uniting the East and the West... "Go... and teach" (Matt. 28:18-20).

We all have a common commandment in this life: "Feed the hungry children." The gifts we receive from God do not belong to us: the food we waste, and the money we greedily hoard belongs to the hungry child; the money we spend frivolously belongs to the hungry child; the money we spend on WMD and war belongs to the hungry children of the world. Jesus says, "Love your enemies, and bless those who curse you, do good to them who hate you..." Let us "bomb" their children with food. We all have a gift for the world table of hungry children—God has given man the capacity to conquer and control hunger.
