

Occupy Madison Reynolds Park

We are guests in the Tenney-Lapham residential neighborhood, who with Madison Police and Madison Parks have welcomed us to Reynolds Park for this weekend. Members of the neighborhood are concerned of the Occupation, the noise, litter and safety of property. The neighborhood has asked that we be respectful.

Madison Mayor Paul Soglin and Madison Parks have waived Park Closing times, which are 10 PM – 4 AM. We need to be mindful to the neighborhood and remain peaceful. We have pledged to be quiet from 7PM to 10AM. Moderate amplification is permitted between 10:30AM – 1:30PM and 5PM – 7PM.

We are able to sleep in the park. Tents **cannot** be set up. We can set up Sun Awnings.

Vending food or merchandise is not permitted to the general public. Cooking and the use of generators are not permitted.

Alcohol, dogs and glass containers are not permitted in the park. Driving on the park property and burning / fires are not permitted.

Bathrooms /Porta Johns are provided and are on the Mifflin Street side of the Park. A wash up station has also been provided.

Trash and Recycling cans have been provided. It is up to us to pick up trash and recycle. Please pitch in. We have pledged that the park will be in the same condition as in which we found it.

Residents of the Tenney-Lapham neighborhood will be present along w/ Madison Police and Park staff and will continually communicate with the Occupation Hosts. Please be respectful of the concerns of the surrounding neighborhoods during the occupation and mindful of the cooperative efforts to have a safe, productive event in which protects our First Amendment rights to assemble peacefully.
